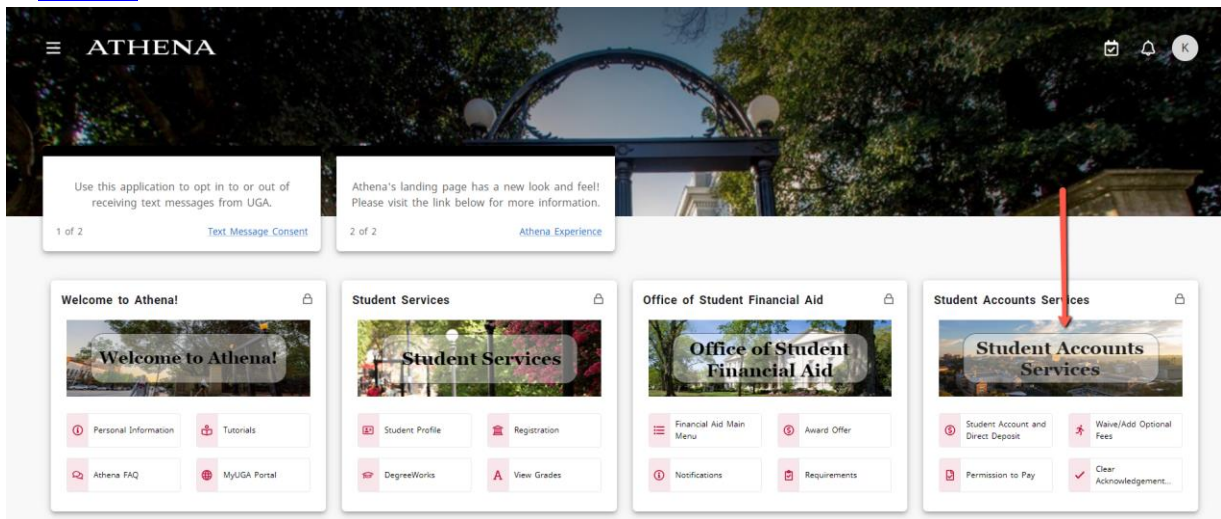
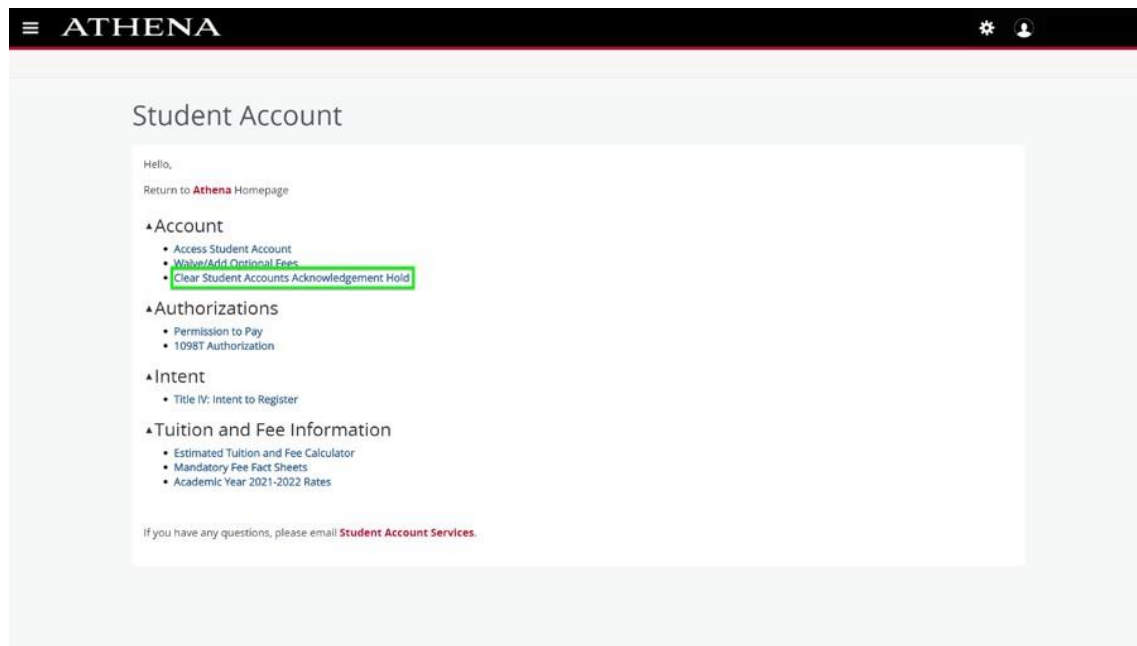


Instructions on How to Clear the Student Account Acknowledgement Hold

INSTRUCTIONS: Read the Student Financial Responsibility Agreement below and indicate your agreement by entering your initials in the box below.

This Agreement is entered into between the Student and the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, by and on behalf of the University of Georgia, in exchange for registering for classes and receiving education services from the University of Georgia. I understand and agree that my eligibility to enroll in classes is expressly conditioned upon acceptance of all terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

I understand and agree to the following:

- When I register for any class at the University of Georgia or receive any service from the University of Georgia, I accept full responsibility to pay all tuition, fees and other associated costs assessed as a result of my registration and/or receipt of services on or before the due date. I understand and agree that if I fail to pay my student account bill or any monies due and owing the University of Georgia by the scheduled due date, the University of Georgia will assess a late fee.
- I understand that administrative, clerical or technical billing errors do not absolve me of my financial responsibility to pay the correct amount of tuition, fees and other associated financial obligations assessed as a result of my registration at the University of Georgia.
- If I drop or withdraw from some or all of the classes for which I register, I will be responsible for paying all or a portion of tuition and fees in accordance with the published refund schedule.
- I am personally responsible for payment of all money due regardless of my eligibility for financial aid or other assistance. I understand the University of Georgia uses electronic billing (e-bill) as its official billing method, and therefore I am responsible for viewing and paying my student account e-bill by the scheduled due date. I further understand that failure to review my e-bill does not constitute a valid reason for not paying my bill on time. I understand I may review my e-bill information by accessing my student account in Athena.
- Financial aid or other financial assistance I receive may be used to pay any and all money due to the University of Georgia, including tuition, fees, campus housing and meal plans, student health insurance, parking permits, service fees, fines, bookstore charges, or any other amount, in accordance with the terms of the aid or assistance. If some or all of my financial aid or other assistance is revoked because I drop or withdraw from classes and/or from school, I will repay all revolved aid that was disbursed to my account.
- I understand I can authorize others (parents, guardians, employers, etc.) to view billing information and/or pay bills on my behalf. I understand granting access to authorized users via my student account is in my control and changes to this access must be adjusted by me. Authorized users do not have access to my stored payment methods, academic records, or other personal information.
- If I fail to pay all money due by the due date, the University of Georgia will place a financial hold on my student account, cancelling my class registration and preventing me from registering for future classes, obtaining transcripts or receiving my diploma.
- If a payment made to my student account is returned by the bank for any reason, I agree to repay the original amount of the payment plus a returned payment fee of \$30. I understand multiple returned payments and/or failure to comply with the terms of any payment plan or agreement I sign with the University of Georgia may result in cancellation/withdrawal of my classes and/or suspension of my eligibility to pay by these same means.
- If I fail to pay all money due by the due date and fail to make payment arrangements acceptable to the University of Georgia, the University of Georgia may refer my account to a collection agency, and I will be responsible for paying the collection agency fee, which may be based on a percentage of up to 15% of the debt, together with all costs and expenses including reasonable attorney's fees, necessary for the collection of my account. I understand my delinquent account may be reported to one or more of the national credit bureaus in the event my account is turned over to a third party for collection.
- I authorize the University of Georgia and its agents to contact me at my current and any future cellular phone number(s), email address(es), and wireless device(s) regarding my delinquent student account(s)/fees(s) or any other debt I owe to the University of Georgia, or to provide general information from the University of Georgia. I authorize the University of Georgia and its agents to use automated telephone dialing equipment, artificial or pre-recorded voice or text messages, and personal calls and email messages, in their efforts to reach me.
- I am responsible for keeping the University of Georgia records up to date with my current physical address(es), email address(es), and phone numbers by updating this information in Athena as a current student or returning the "Change in Address Form" to the Registrar's Office as a former student. My responsibility to do so will continue upon leaving the University of Georgia for any reason for purposes of continued communication regarding any amounts that remain due and owing to the University of Georgia.
- I understand and agree that the University of Georgia uses email as the official means of communication with me, and that therefore I am responsible for reading the emails I receive from the University of Georgia on a timely basis.
- I am subject to and responsible for complying with all applicable University of Georgia and Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia policies and procedures.
- This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia without regard to choice of law provisions, and all actions arising under this Agreement will be filed and litigated exclusively in the appropriate courts within the State of Georgia.
