




- 1. Click the Tools menu and select Internet Options.
- 2. Click the Programs Tab, and then click the Manage add-ons button.



- 3. In the Show box, select All add-ons or Add-ons that have been used by Internet Explorer.
- 4. Scroll through the list until you find Adobe PDF Reader.
- 5. Make sure the status is *Enabled*.



- 6. If Adobe PDF Reader is not visible, you will need to download the latest version of Adobe Reader.
- 7. When opening the 1098-T document, you may be prompted with the Protected View confirmation.
- 8. Select the Options button and click Trust this host always.



9. If the 1098-T statement still displays blank, save the file to the hard drive and open it using Adobe Reader




First, ensure the Adobe PDF browser add-on, nppdf32.dll, is enabled.

- 1. In the Firefox URL address bar, enter about:plugins.
- 2. Scroll to the Adobe Acrobat section and ensure the **State**: is *Enabled*.
- 3. If you cannot find this entry, you will need to install the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader.




4. Next, at the top of the Firefox window, click the Firefox button and select **Options**.


Alternatively, if your Menu bar is visible, click Tools and select Options.




- 5. Select the **Applications** Panel and find **Portable Document Format (PDF)** in the Content Type list.
- 6. Click the drop-down arrow in the Action column for this option and select Use Adobe Acrobat (in Firefox).



7. At this point, some users may find that the 1098-T statement still displays with no data.



8. If this occurs, click the Open With Different Viewer button and select Adobe Reader (default).




9. When Adobe Reader opens, click Enable All Features as shown on the page for Adobe resources.

Viewing PDFs in Google Chrome




- 1. In a Chrome browser URL/address bar, enter chrome://plugins. The screen shown below will display.
- 2. Select the Enable link for Adobe Reader.
- 3. The Chrome PDF Viewer should automatically disable, but if it does not, click it Disable link.



4. You may be prompted for your permission to load the file. If so, click the Always run on this site button.



5. Alternatively, you may see the Protected View prompt. Click Options, and select Trust this host always.



6. If the 1098-T statement still displays blank, save the file to the hard drive and open it using Adobe Reader.





Verify the Adobe Plug-In


1. Open Safari and go to Help > Installed Plug-ins.



2. Confirm that Adobe Acrobat appears in the list of installed Plug-Ins




- 3. Open Finder and select Go > Go to Folder.
- 4. In the Go to the Folder field, enter /Library/Internet Plug-Ins/.





5. Confirm that the AdobePDFViewer.plugin and AdobiePDFViewerNPAPI.plugin files appear in the list.



6. If the plugins are not listed, reinstall Adobe Reader.

After the plugins are properly installed, some users may find that 1098-T statements display with no data.



To view 1098-T statements In Adobe Acrobat Reader, a user must click Enable All Features.




Plug-In Installation


Users who have difficulty viewing PDFs in a browser should verify that the Adobe Plug-in has been installed successfully and enabled.

1. Select Help > About Adobe Plug-Ins...




2. Select the Internet Access Plug-in option. Ensure that the API Loaded status is Yes.






Set Adobe Reader as the default PDF reader

1. Open the Finder and select a PDF file.


2. Select the PDF file and select File > Get Info.
