Debi Chandler called the minutes from the previous meeting to be approved. Minutes were approved.

**Guest Speaker:** Jimmy Williamson, Chief of Police at UGA

- Campus Carry – allowed anywhere other than offices and not in residence halls, 4 arrest for violations of campus carry have been made with those being for weapons violations and irresponsibility, none were aggressive events
- 17 states have passed Campus Carry and 8 more are joining at this time
- Weapon should be concealed with reasonable effort
- Police cannot ask for permit
- Violations are usually a \$25 fee
- There is no current data base on permit holders
- No uptake on carries
- A few gun owners attempted to enter the football stadium (not allowed)
- Probate court is where permits are applied for, once permitted, can carry any legal gun that is easy to conceal and it can be loaded
- Chief stated that in his 30 years at UGA, there has been no serious violence
- FAQ section available on UGA police's website
- Social Media, ex. Craigslist, etc., police have a set up and Ecommerce Zone next to the PD with cameras and abundant lighting to make sales, exchanges, etc. Police will be present if requested
- UGA Police vs. ACC Police jurisdiction is established by the government
- UGA Police have a presence at all UGA properties or Georgia University systems, it is the only university police department in the nation with a bomb squad
- UGA Police employ 114 full time employees and 90 sworn police officers
