Guest Speakers - Assistant Athletic Directors, Glada Horvat and Rhonda Kilpatrick

Shared by Glada

- Makes sure that 500+ athletes meet all eligibility requirements for athletic scholarships and maintain that eligibility
- Athletes may qualify for full, partial or no scholarship
- Athletics pays approximately 4 million to the University for housing, meal plans, tuition, etc. to cover above mentioned scholarships

Shared by Rhonda

- Athletics is a 7 day a week job and almost all 365 days with very little time off
- Student athletes are at the University all year long. Their days are planned in detail lasting approximately 12 hours a day.
- Athletics has construction projects going on a regular basis to accommodate the ever growing populous that is demanded
- Recruiting is no longer months, it is now all year

- Athletes' schedules make academics even more strenuous. Some change majors, etc. The present overall GPA for athletics is an impressive 3.11.
- There are Behavioral, Medical, Dietary, Etiquette, Media Relations, Drug and Alcohol counselors available to all athletes.
- Recruits can be as much as 3 years out, Recruiters delve into the student recruits lives making sure they have attributes that would contribute to the University and the sports they play
- NCAA will be discussing the 1 year red shirt policy and consider changing it.
- The Hartman Fund and SEC are huge contributors to UGA football

Committee Reports:

HR Committee, Health and Safety and Communications – No committee reports, however, it was suggested by Tamela Foreman that the Health and Safety Committee discuss asking Automotive services to install an automatic car wash for UGA vehicles to save time for University vehicles to be washed on campus versus going off campus
